### **Development of the New Rockingham Memorial Hospital Health Campus**

Dennis Coffman will deliver a presentation that will cover the vision for the replacement hospital for Rockingham Memorial Hospital. You will learn about Engineering design aspects of the new facility that will benefit patients and visitors. This visual tour will take you from conception to the current construction status and will include what RMH is doing to build for a second century of service. RMH has pursued certification of its green building effort with the LEED Green Building Rating System. The green building effort includes both the facility itself and the surrounding grounds. Several different Engineering disciplines will be represented within the presentation.



Mr. Coffman is the current Director of Facilities Planning and Development for Rockingham Memorial Hospital. He has worked for the hospital for over 32 years. His current role includes oversight for the design and construction of the new hospital located off Port Republic Road in Harrisonburg, VA. The facility is slated to open in June 2010.

Dennis has a strong commitment to sustaining and caring for the natural environment which has led to the creative use of methane gas from the Rockingham County Landfill. Dennis graduated Summa Cum Laude from Old Dominion University with a degree in Mechanical Engineering.
