

***THE ANNUAL CROZET AWARD  
TO VIRGINIA'S GOVERNMENT  
ENGINEER OF THE YEAR***

The Crozet Award is to recognize a Virginia state or local government engineer who has exhibited outstanding leadership in technical and non-technical fields as well as public service in the Commonwealth. The award honors Colonel Claudius Crozet who was Principal Engineer of Virginia from 1823 to 1842.

***SPONSORSHIP***

- The Crozet Award is an intersociety award of the Virginia engineering community.
- The cosponsors are the Virginia Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers, the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers/Virginia Council, the Consulting Engineers Council of Virginia, and the Virginia Society of Professional Engineers.

***WHO IS ELIGIBLE***

- Any engineer licensed in Virginia who, on the date of his or her nomination, is an employee of the Commonwealth or one of its political subdivisions (cities, counties, towns, authorities) is eligible.
- The nominee need not be a Virginia resident and may be in a technical or managerial position.
- Employees of educational institutions are not eligible for the Award.

***HOW NOMINATIONS ARE MADE***

- The nominator must complete and certify a nomination. Anyone may nominate a candidate. Follow the outline on the reverse side of this sheet.
- Nominations must be addressed to Crozet Award Committee, c/o Virginia Society of Professional Engineers, 9291 Laurel Grove Road, Suite 10, Mechanicsville, VA 23116-2969. The use of the Society is for mailing purposes only.
- Nominations must be postmarked on or before **April 15** in order to be considered by the committee.

***HOW SELECTION IS MADE***

- Judging will be based on the following criteria, with emphasis on leadership and public service:
  - ❖ Significant Achievements
  - ❖ Awards and Honors
  - ❖ Engineering Education
  - ❖ Continuing Engineering Education
  - ❖ Non-Engineering Education
  - ❖ Professional and Engineering Society Activities
  - ❖ Civic Organization and Public Body Activities
  - ❖ Non-Engineering Activities

***PRESENTATION OF THE CROZET MEDAL***

- The Award is presented annually at an appropriate statewide engineering function, which will provide an occasion to recognize the Crozet Award recipient for leadership and engineering excellence in a gathering of Virginia engineering leaders.

## ***NOMINATION FOR THE ANNUAL CROZET AWARD***

Only information contained in the nominations will be used as the basis for selection of the award winner. Please type or print all information using the numbering order below. The total length of the nomination should not exceed three single-spaced typewritten pages. Please submit an original and four (4) copies.

The complete nomination should address each of the following numbered topics:

1. Full name of nominee
2. Current employer (including address and telephone), date of initial employment and current job title
3. Prior employers and dates of employment in reverse chronological order (up to 10 years)
4. Virginia Professional Engineer License and year first obtained
5. Additional professional licenses (state, license number)
6. Significant achievements (e.g., publications, projects, patents, etc. - names, dates)
7. Awards, honors, Who's Who listings, etc. (names, dates)
8. Engineering education (universities, degrees, dates)
9. Continuing engineering education (places, types, dates)
10. Non-engineering education (places, types, dates)
11. Professional and engineering society activities (names, offices held, committees, accomplishments, dates)
12. Civic organizations and public bodies (names, offices held, dates, accomplishments)
13. Support of non-engineering activities (e.g., scouting, volunteer rescue, teaching, help to youth, etc., which was performed for service rather than remuneration. Indicate results obtained.)
14. ***CERTIFICATION:*** I certify that the information given in this nomination is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
